MBA PROGRAM

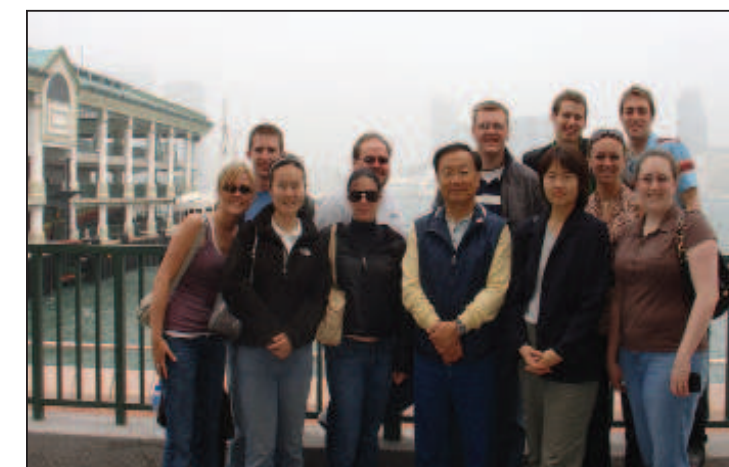
