2. Complete the functional block and capstone courses with an average of 2.25 or higher.
3. Complete at least 50 hours at the 300-400 level.
4. Complete BEIT 492 with a grade of C+ or higher.
5. Complete all courses in the major with a 2.50 grade point average or higher and achieve a g.p.a. of 2.50 or higher for all courses taken.
6. Complete BEIT 307, 317, 320, 336 and 337 with a 2.50 or higher g.p.a. for this block of courses with no grade lower than a C for each course.
7. Complete each course in Phases I, II, and III of the Professional Education sequence with a grade of C or higher and achieve a g.p.a. of 2.50 or higher for all of these courses.
8. Pass Praxis II at the minimum level of competency or higher.
9. Complete Student Teaching satisfactorily.
