



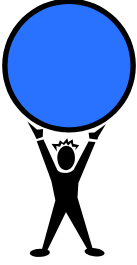

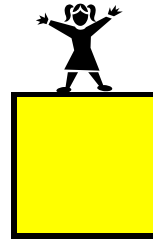

Draw a picture of what you find, or write the word.



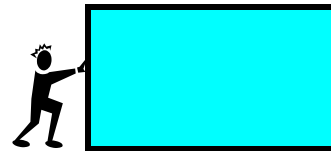

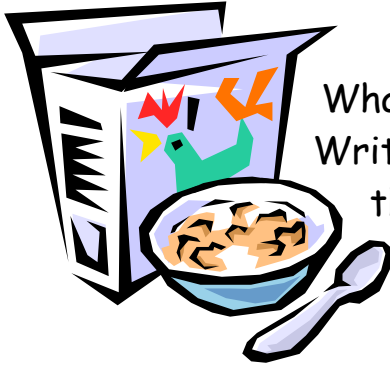

On the way home, look for signs that you can read. When you get home, write or draw what you saw.





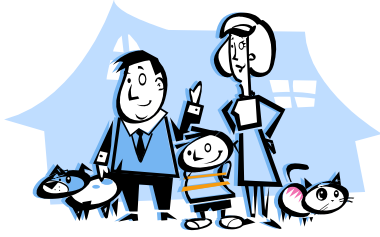
What kind of cereal do you have in your cabinet?

Ask your parents to put some coins on the table. Can you sort the coins?

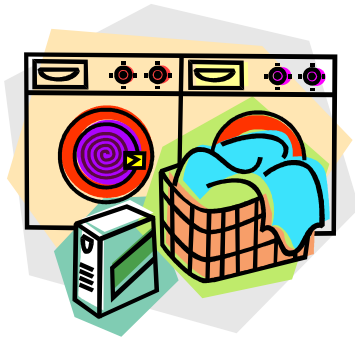
Find all the ones that look the same and put them in their own piles.

Draw a picture of your family, and write their names.

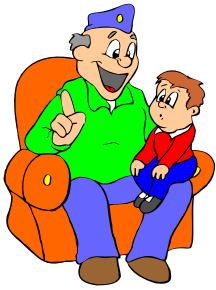


Laundry time

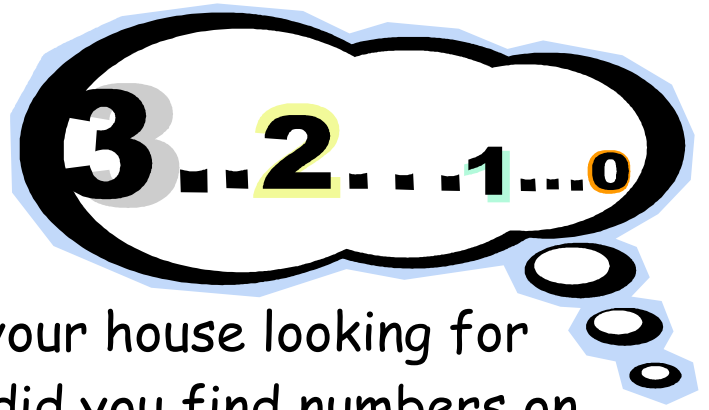
Help sort the socks in the laundry. Can you find the ones that match and go together?

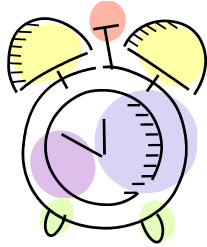


At bath time guess about how many minutes it will take to fill the bathtub for a bath. Then time filling it with a watch. What was your guess? How long did it take to fill the tub?
