

Application Information

The scholarship is available to persons regardless of sex, race, color, creed, age, disability, or veteran status. To be eligible you must meet these criteria:

- Registered in an accredited college or university in the State of Indiana
- Resident of Indiana at the time of entry into the college or university
- Majoring in Human Resources Management, Industrial Relations, or Business Administration with a Human Resources concentration
- Full-time or part-time student
- Junior, senior or graduate student at the time of application

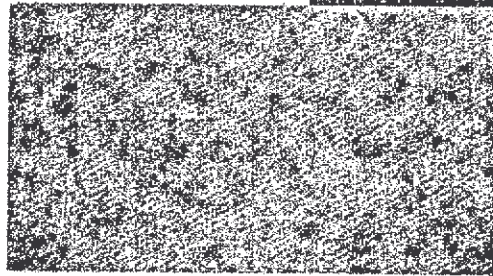
