NOTES:

1. Students complete the Bachelor of Arts degree, rather than the Bachelor of Science degree, by completing fourteen hours of a foreign language.
2. All liberal arts majors complete a total of at least 68 hours of General Education outside the music department in order to meet the National Association of Schools of Music Standard: General studies normally occupy 55 percent to 70 percent of the total curriculum. The 'free electives' above may be applied toward these 68 hours.
3. Music majors must participate in ensembles at least seven semesters of their baccalaureate program. After degree requirements are satisfied, ensembles may be taken for zero OR one credit. If taken for credit, these hours may be applied toward free electives. Music majors with an overall G.P.A. below 2.5 may not participate in more than two ensembles per semester. Freshmen may not participate in more than two ensembles their first semester.
4. Concert/Recital attendance requirements AND the Keyboard Proficiency Exam must be completed before beginning the internship.
5. General Education requirements (above) assume there are no deficiencies in English, math, technology, or foreign language requirements. Free electives (above) may be used toward any deficiencies.
6. At least 50 credit hours must be attained in 300/400-level courses.
