NEW PARKING POLICIES FOR ALL EXTERNAL MEMBERSHIPS
Effective Aug. 16, 2011

Recently the Indiana State University Board of Trustees transferred the supervision of all campus parking lots to the Department of Public Safety (university police). This also required that Public Safety's budget be responsible for the maintenance of the lots. Coupled with the fact that it has been several years without an increase in parking rates, it was decided that an entirely new parking rate structure would be necessary. The new policies dictate that there would no longer be complimentary parking provided for external customers during the normal business hours of the university. In effect, everyone will pay for parking. The below fee structure will be in effect for all Rec Center external members beginning **August 16, 2011**.

1. Park free in any lot before 7:00 a.m. or after 5:00 p.m. Monday-Friday or anytime weekends/holidays.
2. Purchase a hang tag for \$125/yr good for any surface lot. Purchase is good from August 16 – August 15 and can be prorated if purchased in December.
3. Purchase a temporary pass at the rate of \$15/month. This would be a good option for those with shorter membership terms.
4. Park in one of two pay lots at \$1/hr. Lot 11 (immediately adjacent to the north entrance of the Hulman Memorial Student Union) and the North Pay Lot (southwest of the rec center).

For the remainder of this summer members may continue to utilize the temporary parking passes that we have been issuing through the rec center OR park free in the North Pay Lot. All new parking regulations will go into effect August 16. All new parking permits must be purchased from the Department of Public Safety located at the east side of Pickerl Hall just south of the HMSU fountain or at the north termination of 6th street in the middle of campus.
